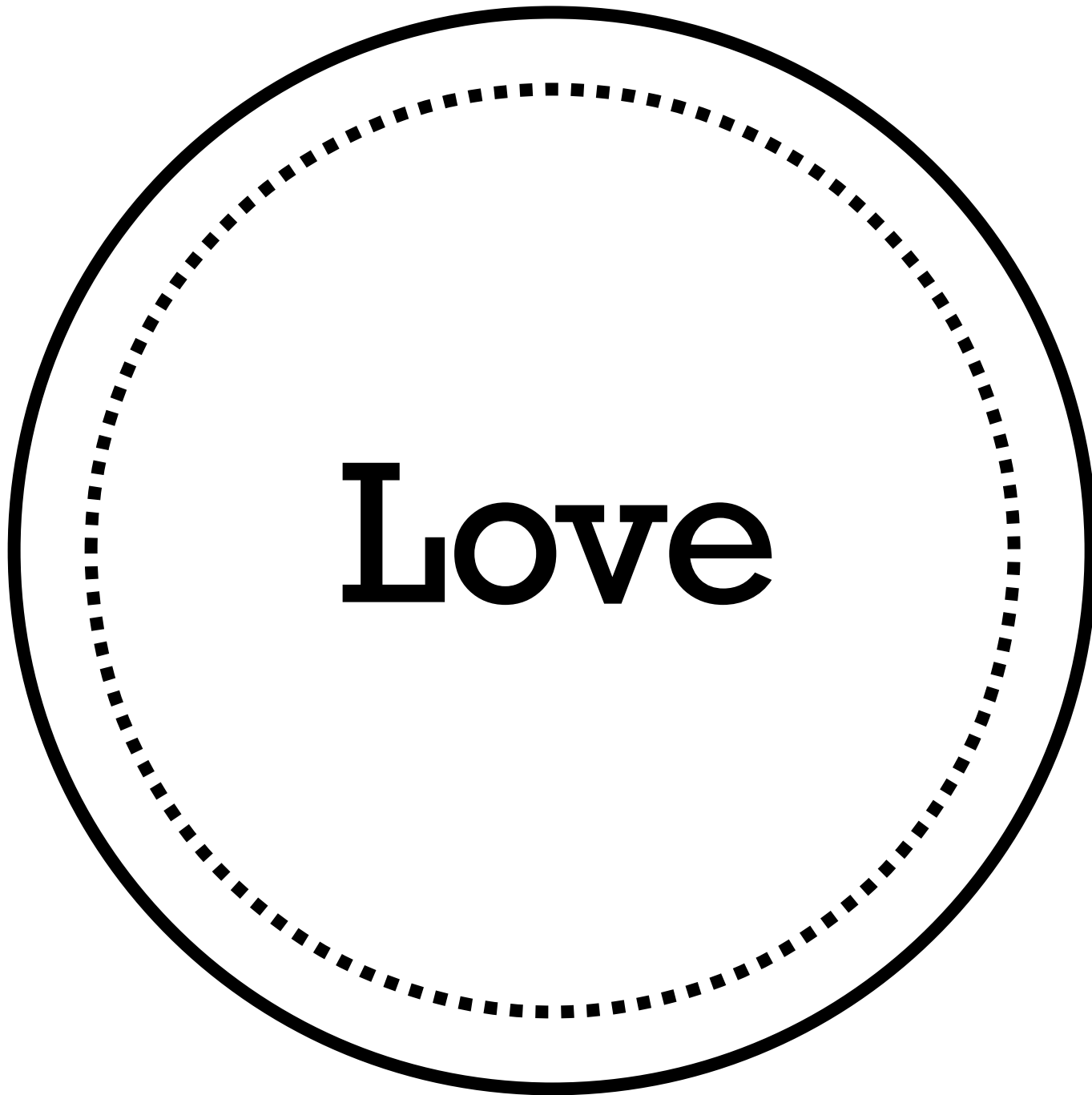
Pray for ways to spread hope to others.

around you.

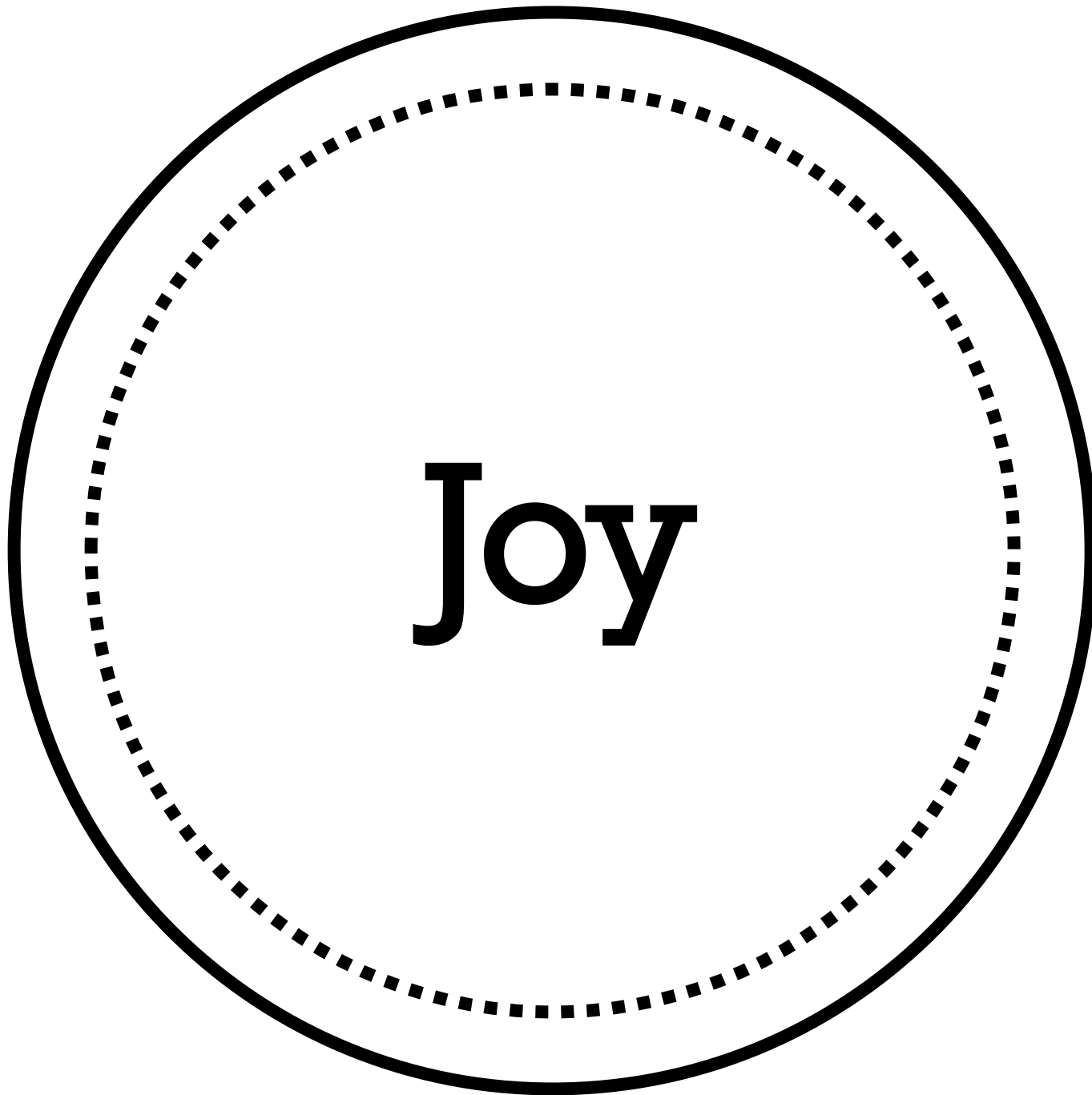
